

FOREIGN LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT

It is the goal of the Foreign Language Department that every student achieves an ability to understand, speak, read and write in the target language, while at the same time developing global awareness and knowledge of different cultures. The completion of two years of the **same** foreign language satisfies the **minimal** high school foreign language prerequisite for entrance to most **four-year** colleges. It should be noted that many institutions of higher learning require **three or four** years of foreign language study at the high school level.

It is strongly recommended that all students select one (1) Foreign Language course. Parents and students should give **careful consideration** to which language they choose, as the students will **not be able to change languages** once they have returned their **signed** course selection worksheet to their guidance counselor. They may choose from a Foreign Language offered at Advanced Placement, Honors, College, and Heritage Language Speaker level.

A student may **not** elect a beginning level language class after the **first two weeks** of school. Students are advised to take the two years of a language **consecutively**, as leaving a gap between courses may jeopardize students' chances of passing. Students who choose to begin their language study at Lowell High School at the second or third year level should contact the Department Head for an interview or a placement exam. Heritage Language speakers will also take a placement exam to determine proper scheduling. During the 2013-2014 academic year, Latin will have honors and AP sections; French and Spanish will have separate honors and college sections for most levels; and Portuguese and Khmer will have combined honors and college levels.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

2080 FOREIGN LANGUAGE INTERN 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

This course is designed to attract students who have achieved mastery of basic foreign language concepts, and who wish to help other students do the same. They must be nominated by a foreign language teacher, and obtain approval of the department chair. These students will help teachers in their classrooms, language lab, and computer lab.

LATIN OPTIONS

2113 LATIN IA - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

This is an accelerated course for students who have demonstrated honors level work. It is designed to prepare students for general reading in Latin. Thorough training is given in the basic vocabulary, forms and syntax of the language along with practice in sight-reading. The student is also introduced to Roman history and to the relationship of Latin to the English language.

2114 LATIN IB - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2113.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2113.

2123 LATIN IIA - Honors 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Rapid review of Latin I grammar, continuing with intensive work in nearly all grammatical concepts; translation from Roman history and myths.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2114 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2124 LATIN IIB - Honors 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2123.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2123.

2133 LATIN IIIA - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

As above, with additional readings from Ovid, and the plays of Plautus. Figures of speech and rhetorical devices.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2124 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2134 LATIN IIIB - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2133.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2133.

2135 LATIN IIIA - Advanced Placement 11 2.5 Cr.

This course is designed to prepare the student for the Advanced Placement Latin Exam on Virgil. It will focus on Books 1- 6 of the *Aeneid*, and will begin to prepare the student for taking the exam at the end of the Latin IV.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 90 OR HIGHER IN 2124 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2136 LATIN IIIB - Advanced Placement 11 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2135.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 80 OR HIGHER IN 2135 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2143 LATIN IVA - Honors 12 2.5 Cr.

Readings from Virgil's *Aeneid*, and other works of Roman poets. Background in epic poetry and poetic language. Background in Roman law, oratory, and government.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2134.

2144 LATIN IVB - Honors 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2143.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2322 OR 2324. IT IS STRONGLY SUGGESTED THAT THE STUDENT HAVE A 70 IN FRENCH 2 TO MOVE ON.

2332 FRENCH IIIB - College 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2331.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2331.

2333 FRENCH IIIA - Honors 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Entails written and oral work based on an analysis of texts. A total picture of grammar is presented with special emphasis on expanded idiom study. The student is required to do an adequate amount of reading both intensive and comprehensive. Pace of course is rapid.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2324 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2334 FRENCH IIIB - Honors 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2333.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2333.

2341 FRENCH IVA - College 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Study of the finer points of grammar as well as the literature of France, via samplings of a wide variety of styles and genres. Oral expression and written composition are integrated with the work in the literary texts.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2332 OR 2334.

2342 FRENCH IVB - College 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2341.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2341.

2343 FRENCH IVA - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Encompasses an introduction to French literature through the reading of selected excerpts of masterpieces of the major genres and philosophies. Reading and analysis of text used as a basis for conversation. Study of the finer points of grammar and written expression.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2334, OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2344 FRENCH IVB - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2344.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2343.

SPANISH OPTIONS

2511 SPANISH IA - College 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A course for students who seek to meet college requirements, and for those who are following a college preparatory program. This course introduces the basics of a foreign language with an emphasis on correct pronunciation, formal grammar (verb tenses, pronouns, etc.), listening comprehension, reading and writing in the foreign language, and a study of the customs and traditions of the Spanish-speaking people.

2512 SPANISH IB - College 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2511.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2511.

2513 SPANISH IA - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

An accelerated course offered to students who are doing honors level work. Grammatical and idiomatic structures, reading, correct pronunciations, oral practice, aural comprehension, and customs and traditions of Spanish-speaking countries are introduced at a quicker pace than 2511.

2514 SPANISH IB - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2513.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2513.

2521	SPANISH IIA - College	9, 10, 11, 12	2.5 Cr.
Reviews the work of course 2502 and continues with a more concentrated study of grammar and an increased emphasis on the skills learned in the first year: speaking, listening comprehension, reading comprehension, writing in the foreign language, and an introduction to the history and geography of Spain and Latin America.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2502, 2504, 2512, OR 2514.</i>			
2522	SPANISH IIB - College	9, 10, 11, 12	2.5 Cr.
A continuation of 2521.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2521.</i>			
2523	SPANISH IIA - Honors	9, 10, 11, 12	2.5 Cr.
In addition to the continuing study of grammar, aural and reading comprehension, speaking and writing for enjoyment are all strengthened. Since most students are highly motivated and college-bound, this class proceeds as rapidly as possible to meet the standards of college entrance requirements.

A continuation of 2531.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2531.</i>			
2533	SPANISH IIIA - Honors	10, 11, 12	2.5 Cr.
Work in grammar emphasizes the finer points and idiomatic usage. The skills in writing, reading, and aural comprehension, together with oral expression are strengthened, and literature in Spanish is introduced.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 70 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2524 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.</i>			
2534	SPANISH IIIB - Honors	10, 11, 12	2.5 Cr.
A continuation of 2533.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2533.</i>			
2535	SPANISH IIIA - Advanced Placement	11	2.5 Cr.
Designed to prepare the student for taking the AP Spanish Language Exam, this course will focus on grammar and writing, listening comprehension, picture stories, and spontaneous speaking as a preparation for taking the exam at the end of Spanish IV AP.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 90 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2524 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.</i>			
2536	SPANISH IIIB - Advanced Placement	11	2.5 Cr.
A continuation of 2535.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 80 OR HIGHER IN 2535 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.</i>			
2541	SPANISH IVA - College	11, 12	2.5 Cr.
This course is a continuation of work done in College Spanish III with emphasis on vocabulary building through a study of idiomatic expressions and selected readings. Aural comprehension and oral expression skills are strengthened.			
<i>PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2531 OR 2533.</i>			
2542	SPANISH IVB - College	11, 12	2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2541.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2541.

2543 SPANISH IVA - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Primarily for those students who wish to perfect their skills in reading, writing and speaking Spanish. Literature is read and oral work is required. The finer points of grammar are studied.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 65 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2536, 70 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2534 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2544 SPANISH IVB - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2544.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2544.

2545 SPANISH IVA - Advanced Placement 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of course of 2535/2536, this course is designed to complete the preparation for taking the AP Spanish Language Exam. This course will use a variety of materials to strengthen all four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

PREREQUISITE: 2535/2536.

2546 SPANISH IVB - Advanced Placement 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2545.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 80 OR HIGHER IN 2545 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2551 SPANISH CONVERSATION I - College 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

This course is designed for Intermediate Limited Spanish proficient students. Designed to increase the student's ability to express himself/herself on "everyday" topics. There will be drills on correct expression and pronunciation. Conversation can be elected for either one semester or for two semesters, as the topics for discussion will vary. The course is **not** designed as a **replacement** for course 2531, 2533, 2541, or 2543, though it may be elected in addition to the aforementioned.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2522 OR 2524.

2552 SPANISH CONVERSATION II - College 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Same as Course 2551. This course offers the student an opportunity for further development in conversational skills.

PREREQUISITE: SAME AS 2551.

2553 SPANISH CONVERSATION I - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

An accelerated course offered to High Intermediate Limited Spanish proficient students who wish to express themselves on "everyday" topics. Students will utilize more advanced grammatical skills such as the subjunctive. This course is not a replacement for courses 2531, 2533, 2541, 2543, although it may be elected in addition to the aforementioned.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 70 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2524 OR A GRADE OF 85 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2522.

2554 SPANISH CONVERSATION II - Honors 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Same as Course 2553. Offers the student an opportunity for further development in conversational skills.

PREREQUISITE: SAME AS COURSE 2553.

2501 SPANISH IA FOR THE HERITAGE LANGUAGE SPEAKER - College 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

This course is designed for students who have native listening/speaking skills in Spanish, and who seek to meet college entrance requirements. This course emphasizes correct pronunciation, formal grammar (verb tenses, pronouns, etc.), listening comprehension, reading and writing in the foreign language, and a study of the customs and traditions of the Spanish-speaking people. It will initially move at a quicker pace than course #2513, and will have a different emphasis, - more on reading and writing structure, with a **rapid review** of basic vocabulary.

PREREQUISITE: Placement involving exam or consultation with department head.

Elected by college-bound students with no previous knowledge of Khmer. This course is an introduction to the Khmer language: basic grammar, conversation, reading, writing, and an introduction to the customs, traditions, and culture of Khmer-speaking people.			
2712	KHMER IB - College	9, 10, 11, 12	2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2711.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2711.

2713 KHMER IA - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

An accelerated course offered to students who are doing honors level work. This course is an introduction to the Khmer language: basic grammar, conversation, reading, writing, and an introduction to the customs, traditions, and culture of Khmer-speaking people.

2714 KHMER IB - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2713.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2713.

2721 KHMER IIA - College 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Reviews the work of course 2712 and continues with a more concentrated study of grammar and the alphabet, sounds and characters, reading and writing.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2712.

2722 KHMER IIB - College 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2721.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2721.

2723 KHMER IIA - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

Reviews the work of course 2714 and continues with a more concentrated study of grammar and the alphabet, sounds and characters, reading and writing. Since most students are highly motivated and college-bound, this class proceeds as rapidly as possible to meet the standards of college entrance requirements.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 70 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2714 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2724 KHMER IIB - Honors 9, 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2723.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2723.

2731 KHMER IIIA - College 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

The skills of reading, writing, speaking, and listening are emphasized, especially in practical, every day usage.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2722 OR 2724.

2732 KHMER IIIB - College 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2731.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2731.

2733 KHMER IIIA - Honors 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

The skills of reading, writing, speaking, and listening are emphasized, especially in practical, every day usage. Since most students are highly motivated and college-bound, this class proceeds as rapidly as possible.

PREREQUISITE: A GRADE OF 70 OR HIGHER IN COURSE 2724 OR PERMISSION OF DEPARTMENT CHAIR.

2734 KHMER IIIB - Honors 10, 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

A continuation of 2733.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN 2733.

2741 KHMER IVA - College 11, 12 2.5 Cr.

The four skills are improved, with authentic Khmer materials (legends, readers, tapes, etc.) being the primary focus of the class.

PREREQUISITE: A PASSING GRADE IN COURSE 2732 OR 2734.
