

## About This Report

This report offers figures and tables that summarize ratings made by staff, teachers and youth on the Survey of Academic and Youth Outcomes (SAYO). The report focuses on changes in mean ratings between the Pre-SAYO, administered in Fall 2024, and the Post-SAYO, administered in Spring 2025. The report also uses Enrollment data to present program demographics (Part 1). For analyses that compare SAYO outcomes between subgroups, see the Special Populations report that was sent alongside this Summary Report.

## Your Program's SAYO and Enrollment Data

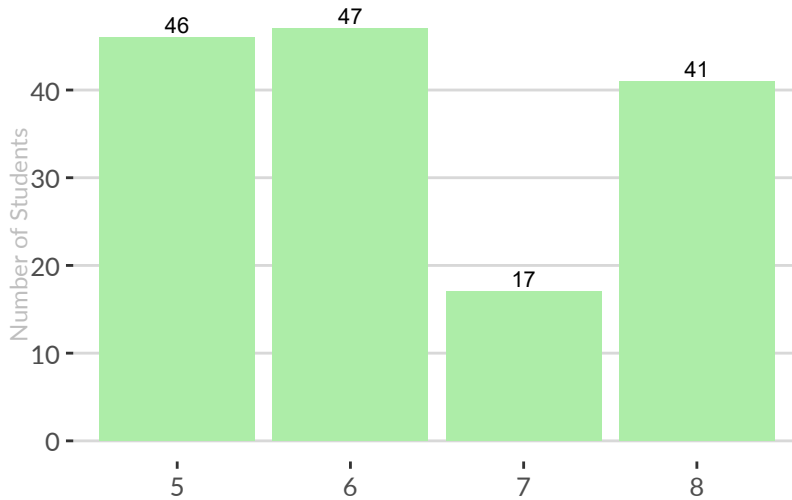
SAYO data, Enrollment data, and SASIDs that match across both datasets

This report is based on Enrollment data and SAYO data. Some of the below analyses are only possible when there are matching SASIDs between the Enrollment data file (which includes demographics) and the SAYO data file. The table on the right shows how many unique SASIDs are located in the Enrollment data file and how many are matched to SASIDs in the SAYO data file. On occasion a SASID is missing from a data file or the entry is invalid because of the number of digits in the SASID. The Special Populations report that was sent alongside this report uses demographic information from the Enrollment data file to compare SAYO outcomes between subgroups. Part 1 of this Summary Report uses data from the Enrollment data file. Discrepancies in this report between demographic data (Part 1) and SAYO Data (Parts 2-4) may be due to the differences in submitted data shown in the table to the right.

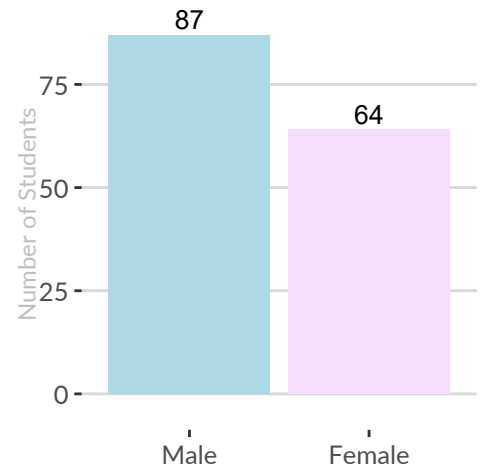

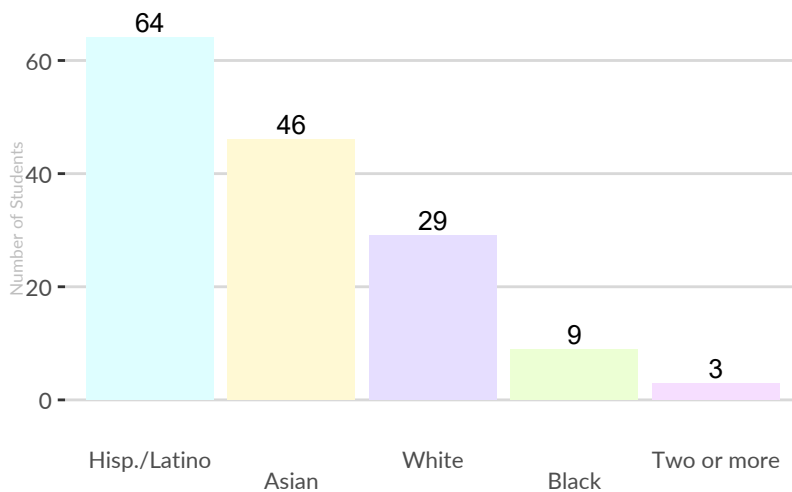

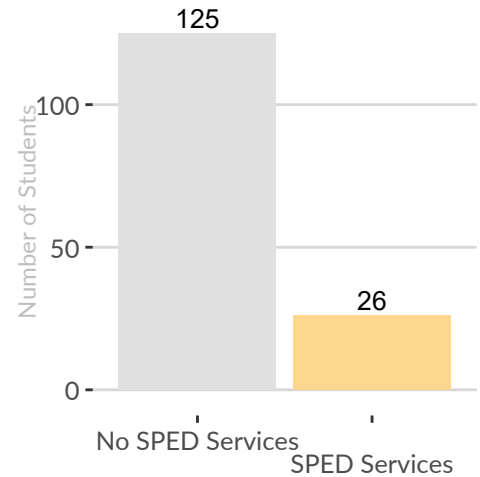

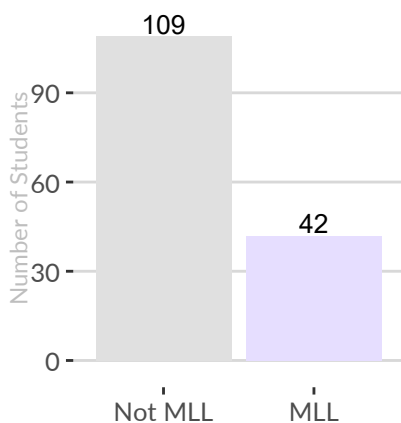

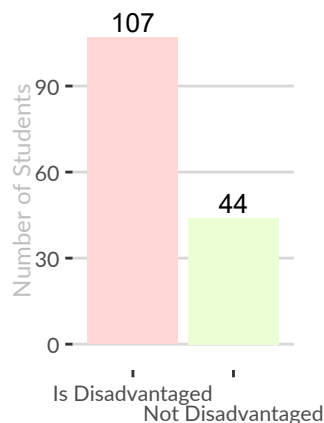

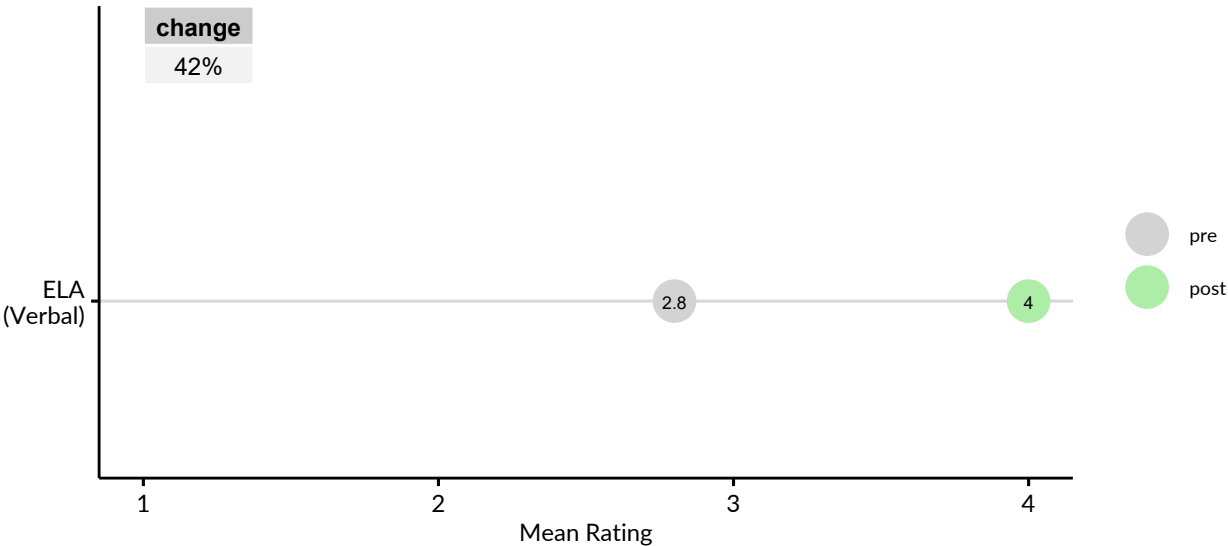

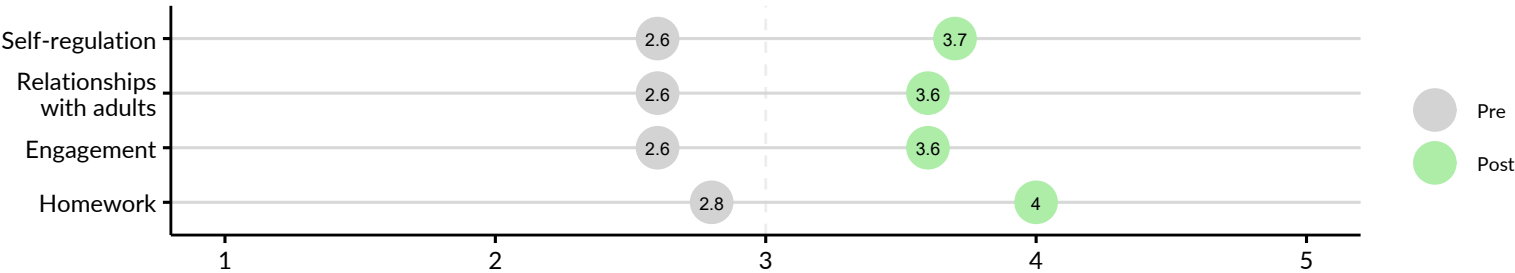

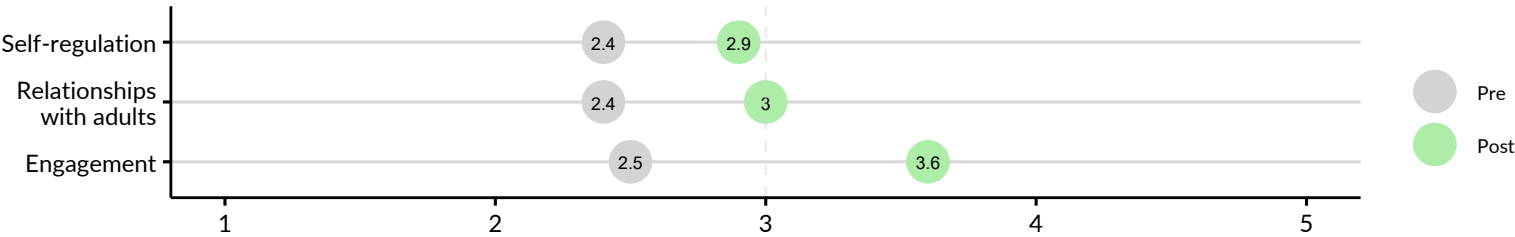

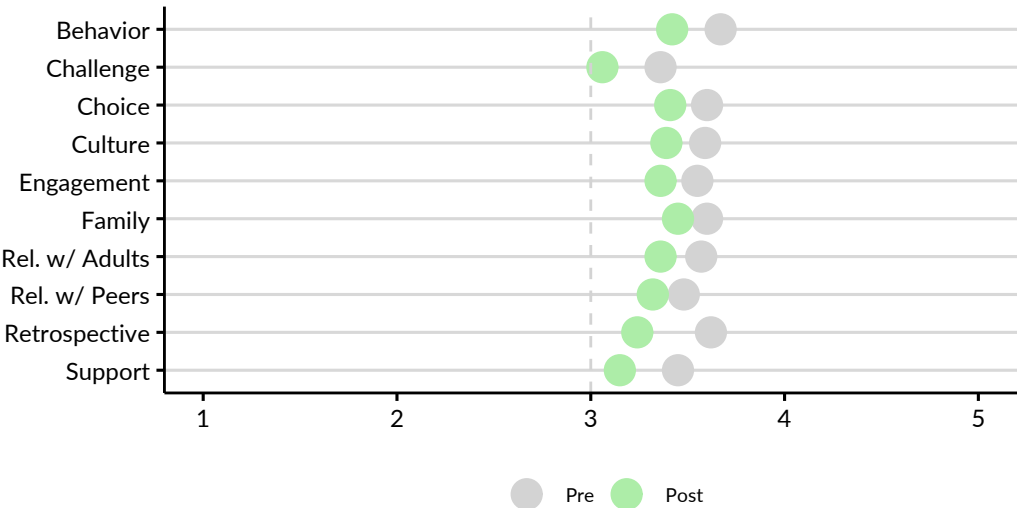
Staff ratings (SAYO S) pre vs. post by area

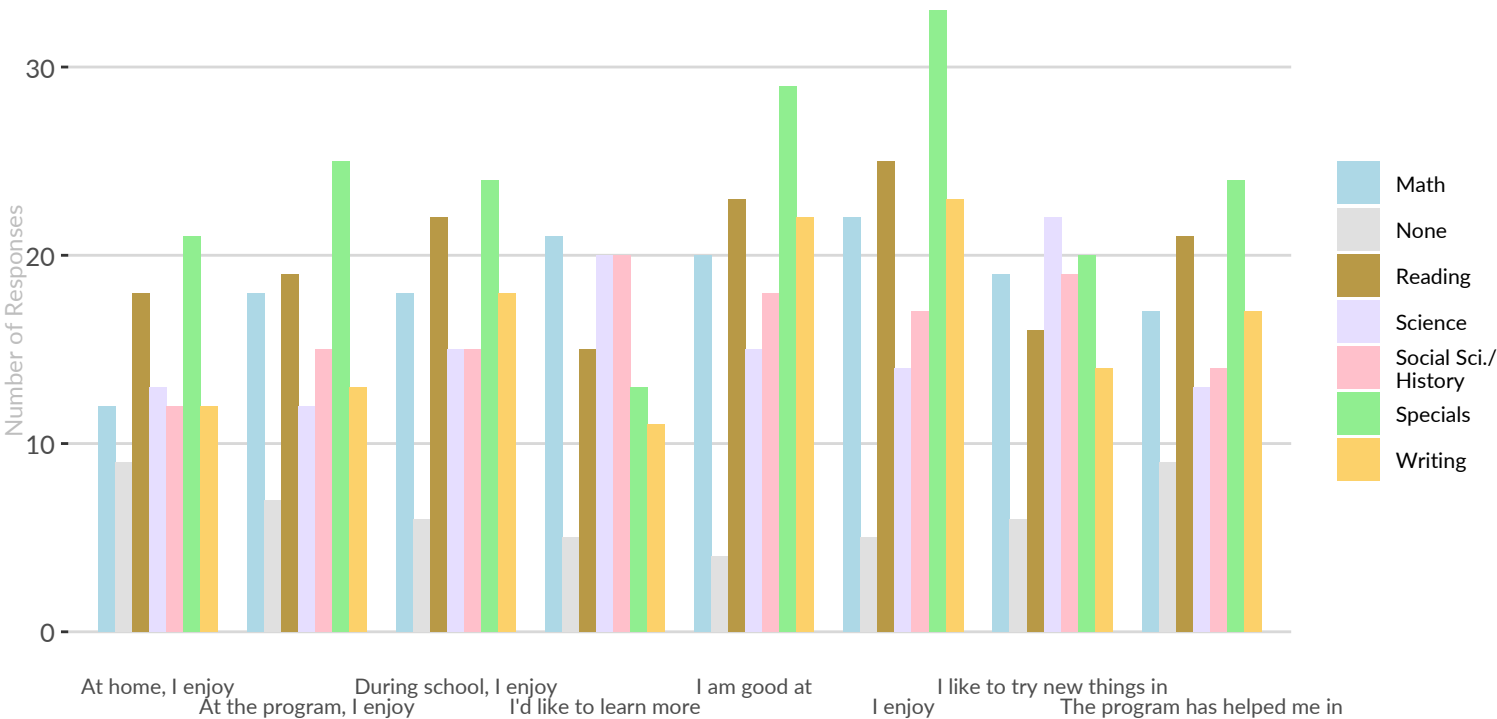
