

Lunch/Recess Monitor Position Description

Lunch Room-Recess Monitor Job Goal: To provide supervision of students during lunch and recess

Performance Responsibilities:

Assist in the supervision of students during lunch and indoor/outdoor recess. Maintain professional and respectful relationships with students. Assist in the cleaning of cafeteria tables after lunches. Establish and maintain standards of student behavior according to expectations and guidelines set by the school. Assist with and orchestrate playground activities and equipment. Receive yearly training from our school nurse for negative allergy response (EPI pen), and first aid response. Maintain appropriate school confidentiality. Act as a Mandated Reporter (Chapter 119, Section 51A). Comply with the Non-Violent Crisis Intervention Policy. Perform any other related duties assigned by the Principal.

Special Knowledge/Ability Required for the Position:

Must be able to work collaboratively and cooperatively with school staff; have the ability to interact respectfully with teachers, staff, parents, students, and community members to promote a positive view of the school; and have the ability to work as a member of a team to promote the mission and goals of the school. Physical Requirements: The position requires a moderate amount of walking, standing, sitting and climbing stairs and step stool whenever necessary. Activities also include moderate physical exertion in body movement such as reaching, bending, twisting, grasping, pushing, and pulling of objects. The position requires lifting objects of 20 pounds or over occasionally.

Environmental Conditions:

The employee is required to work indoors and outdoors. The regular chemical solvents are cleaning fluids.
