5. How do the characters respond to the problem in the story?

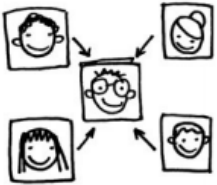


6. Explain your theories about a character (more than one idea you are having).



Find parts that support your ideas.

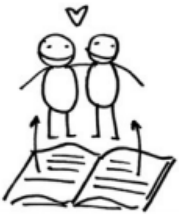
7. Discuss your ideas/theories about the minor characters in the story.
