- Walk-ins are available. Many locations offer walk-in appointments; please call or check their websites to confirm.
- Language assistance may be available. Some locations may provide translators.
- The vaccine is free. The vaccine is available and free (you do not need health insurance) to anyone who lives, works, or studies in Massachusetts.
- Some vaccines require two doses. The Pfizer and Moderna vaccines require a second dose, 21 to 28 days later.
- The vaccine is available for ages 12 and older. The Pfizer vaccine is offered to ages 12-17; Johnson & Johnson and Moderna vaccines are ages 18+.
- You do not need to be a US citizen. You don't need to be a citizen or have a green card to get the vaccine, and getting the vaccine will not affect your immigration status.
- The vaccine is safe. It is not possible to get COVID-19 from the vaccine. Mild side effects are common, but go away within a few days.
