When scheduling your HiSET® test at an official test center or at home, enter the promo code MAHSET during checkout.

## CELEBRATING BLACK HISTORY MONTH

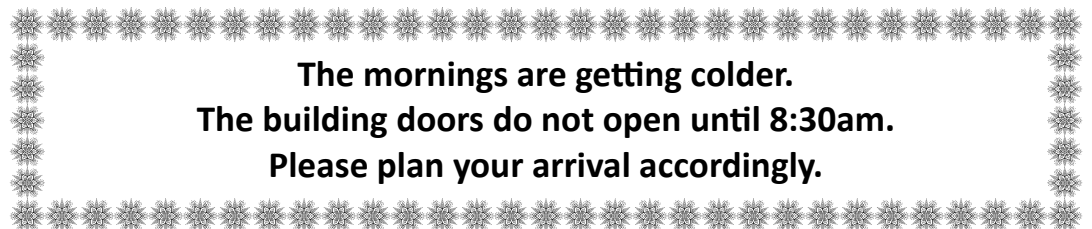


Abisi Adult Education joins the entire Lowell community in recognizing and celebrating Black History Month.

## VISITOR POLICY

Lowell Public School Policy states all outside visitors must report to the main office and sign in and out. ## SCHOOL INFORMATION

### HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY (HSE) TESTING INFORMATION




The Massachusetts High School Equivalency credential is issued by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to those who have passed the HiSET exam, the GED exam, or a combination of the two exams.

Candidates must create an account at [hiset.org](https://hiset.org) and/or [ged.com](https://ged.com) to schedule their testing appointments and see their subtest scores. If a candidate chooses to combine scores from both exams, the combined subject scores will be available after the student completes all their testing, and the transcript is generated at [www.diplomasender.com](https://www.diplomasender.com).

Last fall, the HiSET exam was acquired by a new company, PSI. All HiSET testers must create a myHiSET Account at [hiset.org](https://hiset.org). If you previously created an account with ETS, use the same email address and last name to ensure that all your data (including test scores) is transferred.

**NEW! Effective February 6, 2023, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will pay for a candidate's first HiSET® test in each subject, plus two retakes per subject.** When scheduling your HiSET® test at an official test center or at home, enter the promo code **MAHiSET** during checkout.

**GED Testing is also FREE for Massachusetts residents.** When scheduling a subject test at a Test Center for the first time, use the voucher code: **MAFREEGED**. For a retest to be taken at a GED test center, use the voucher code: **MARETAKE**.

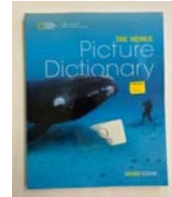
AAEC is an approved Test Center. We offer testing appointments for the HiSET on paper, HiSET on Computer, and GED (computer only).

## CITIZENSHIP CORNER

### Should I Consider U.S. Citizenship?

Many lawful permanent residents, or Green Card holders, are interested in becoming U.S. citizens. Why? According to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) citizenship status offers many benefits.

Here are some important reasons to consider U.S. citizenship:

**Vote.**

Only citizens can vote in federal elections. Most states also restrict the right to vote, in most elections, to U.S. citizens.

**Serve on a jury.**

Only U.S. citizens can serve on a federal jury. Most states also restrict jury service to U.S. citizens. Serving on a jury is an important responsibility for U.S. citizens.

**Travel with a U.S. passport.**

A U.S. passport enables you to get assistance from the U.S. government when overseas, if necessary.

**Bring family members to the U.S.**

U.S. citizens generally get priority when petitioning to bring family members permanently to this country.

**Obtain citizenship for children under 18 years of age.**

In most cases, a child born abroad to a U.S. citizen is automatically a U.S. citizen.

**Apply for federal jobs.**

Certain jobs with government agencies require U.S. citizenship.

**Become an elected official.**

Only citizens can run for federal office (U.S. Senate or House of Representatives) and for most state and local offices.

**Keep your residency.**

A U.S. citizen's right to remain in the United States cannot be taken away.

**Become eligible for federal grants and scholarships.**

Many financial aid grants, including college scholarships and funds given by the government for specific purposes, are available only to U.S. citizens.

**Obtain government benefits.**

Some government benefits are available only to U.S. citizens.
