Budget Voted on Last Year: All positions had been restored; addition of two paraprofessionals and a tutor; the behavioral para and we have a floater paraprofessional that will be heading to grades 2-4; added a tutor position (12 tutor) (1 SEL tutor/11 Math and ELA)

We have a new ELA curriculum; called ARC. We are doing a combination of classroom instruction and pull out instruction. All students would stay in for the core lesson and then there is an intervention block.

Open Forum:

Question about tutoring; every grade gets tutoring during a position of their ELA block and Math block.

Discussion about sidewalks. Parents discussed that trial sidewalks were put up and swiftly were taken down. Shared pictures of multiple steps they tried for temporary sidewalks. The temporary sidewalks upset the neighborhood. August 6th they were pulled down. Have not heard from the city. There were positive comments on facebook. The next meeting will be held with the City Council tomorrow 9/9.

Kim- Morning program has 60 students to alleviate the number of walkers.

Discussion- Clearer message to the families that students are being dropped off at the top at a rolling drop-off; some families are choosing to park and walk their child down. That causes traffic.

Kim- The playground has been deemed unsafe. It has been requested by the school dept. for it to be removed. Unknown when/if this will happen. There is no current funding to replace it. Some parks are considered city parks and some are considered school parks. The wear and tare on our park has been from city baseball traffic. The district has to fund it rather than the city. There are discussions between the district and city to work through that.
