Last year's budget went to tutoring/paraprofessionals; all students in literacy double dipped who are below grade level.

Principal/Literacy Specialist met with all staff to double check in data meetings that all students are getting what they need.

Not as many math tutors.

Additional support staff; two paraprofessionals in each grade level; offer breaks and walks and intervene with behaviors who need extra support in SEL

Added an additional Social Worker; Lessons in classrooms and sending home skills that are being taught. Tier II instruction for SEL

Library position has been extended to be funded for one more year. (Grant Funded from the district.)

Sara B. - Two extra paras in each grade level; can we still allocate for that? Is that part of the Covid relief?

Principal- It will depend; if we don't have as much money this year we will just have to decide where we will cut; it would not have to be paraprofessionals. It could be from supplies, etc.

Last year's budget book came out March 8th. By April is budget defenses Less money could be advocated to big curriculum purchases
