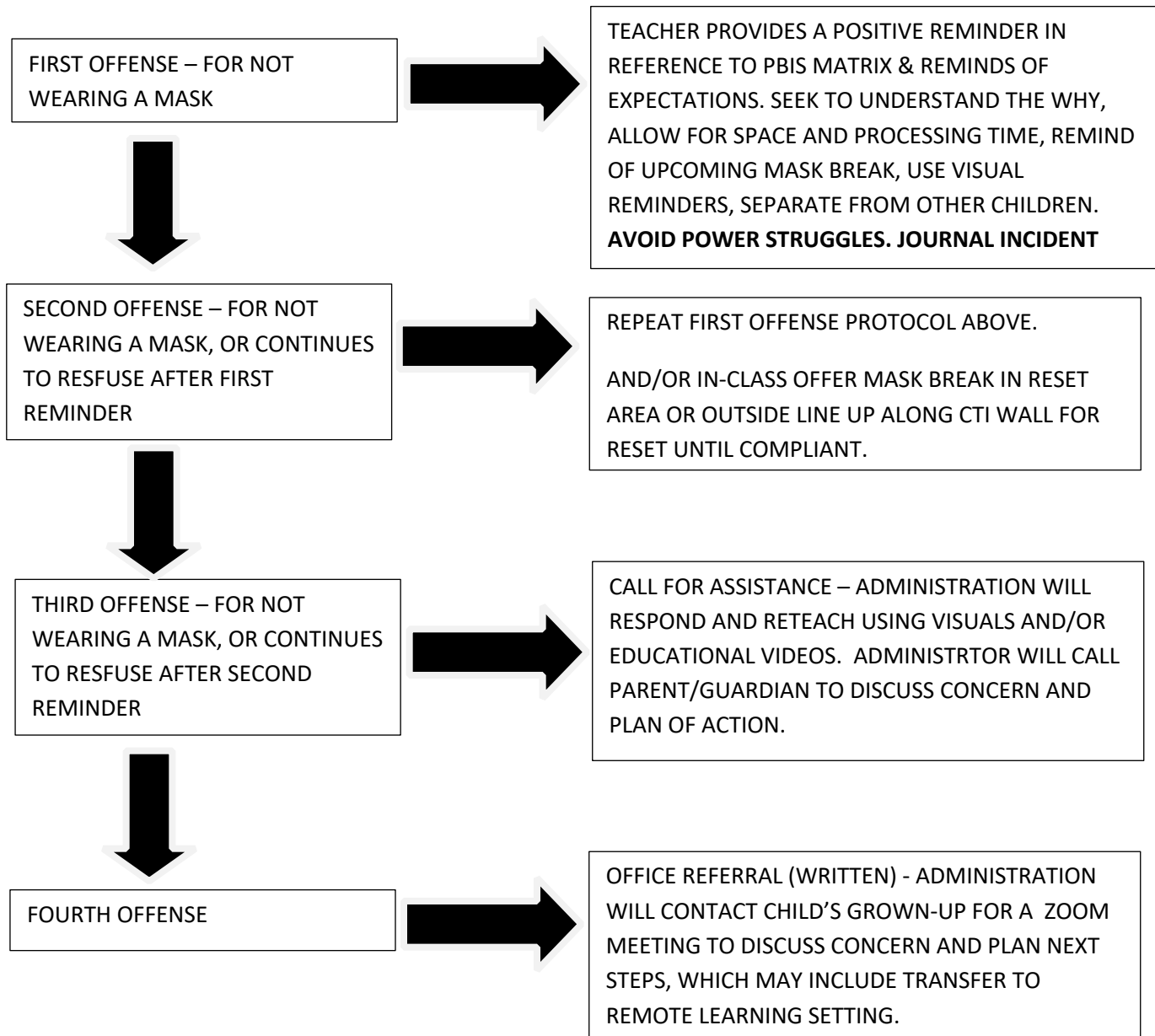


Frederic T. Greenhalge Elementary School Mask Refusal Intervention Plan – Snapshot

ALL CHILDREN/PERSONS ENTERING THE BUILDING ARE
REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK

Anyone seeking to enter the building without a face mask will be directed to the PPE station outside the building or to the Principal or designee at school entry ways. No one can enter the building without their mask on. See chart below if students refuse to wear a mask.

Kids and masks: Different approaches for different ages

Children who are 2 or older can safely wear masks. But for them to do it consistently at school, their parents and other guardians should explain why and how, tailoring their approach based on the age of their child.

Age range	Guidance
Babies and toddlers under 2	Not recommended
2-4	Help your 'I-do-it-all-by-myself' child learn to correctly put on and take off their own mask
4-6	Encourage by example since kids this age like to mimic what their parents and siblings do
6-12	Focus on rules, making it clear that children must wear masks during school hours
13 and up	Appeal to their need to fit in at a time when everyone's doing this
