Holocaust survivor, George Elbaum spoke with Suzanne Riley and Jessica Lander's classes on Thursday, 4/11







George Elbaum was born in Poland in 1938. He was an only child. In 1939 Hitler invades Poland, his father is taken and he and his mother are sent to the Warsaw ghetto where they struggle to survive. In 1942 they escape the ghetto and George's mother decides she must hide her son to save him. She places him with a series of Polish Catholic families who raise him for the next 3 years. His name is changed each time. His mother returns to get him after the war and they come to America in 1949. His life begins again. George shared his journey where he made a huge impact on the students who were there as evidenced by the pictures taken and number of students who waited to speak with him afterwards. We were so fortunate to have him come to our school and share his life story with us. Thank you to Jessica, Suzanne and Robert for making this possible!
