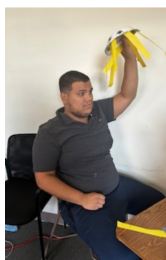
Mr. Dan's Class

Fun with apples in Mr. Dan's class!



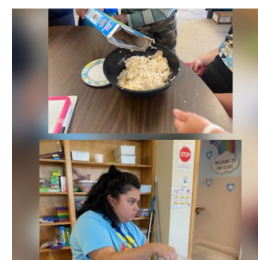
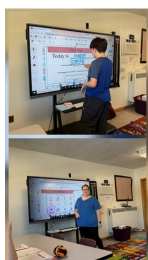
Ms. Raji's Class

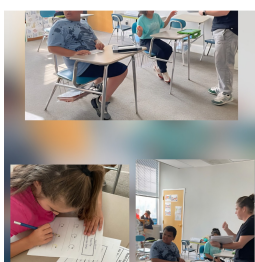
Ms. Casey's Class

Wings for Autism

Wings for Autism(TM) is a free program specifically designed to support families of children with autism, creating a travel test run to help ease the stress of airline travel. By getting comfortable with the airport and flight experience (without actually leaving the airport) parents and their children with special needs can gain the familiarity and confidence they need to take future trips.

During this free, half-day event, children and their families are able to familiarize themselves with the airport and travel procedures.

They experience ...

- Entering the airport
- The check-in process and checking bags
- Security screening
- Boarding the plane
- Preparing for take-off

- Exiting the plane

Practicing these steps helps establish a travel routine—so important for many children with autism who rely on repetition and structure.

Wing for Autism events are held regularly in April and November at Boston Logan Airport, and periodically at other regional airports throughout New England.

Autism Waiver Service Program-Open Enrollment

Applications for the 2025 DDS Children's Autism Service Program Open Request Period will open on October 17th. Students are eligible **under age 10**.

The Autism Division of the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) administers the Children's Autism Waiver Program (AWP) which provides one-to-one interventions to help children with autism who exhibit severe behavioral, social and communication challenges through a service called Expanded Habilitation, Education (intensive in-home services and supports). This service occurs in the child's home or other natural settings under the supervision of trained clinical staff and is available for a total of three years. AWP also provides related support services such as community integration activities and respite. At the conclusion of the three years of intensive services, a child may access supplemental services that meet the child's needs and help with the transition out of the intensive AWP until the child's 10th birthday.

The 2025 Children's Autism Waiver Open Request Period information and application forms will be available in September 2025. The 2025 open request period runs from **October 17 through October 31, 2025**. Applications will be accepted during this period only.

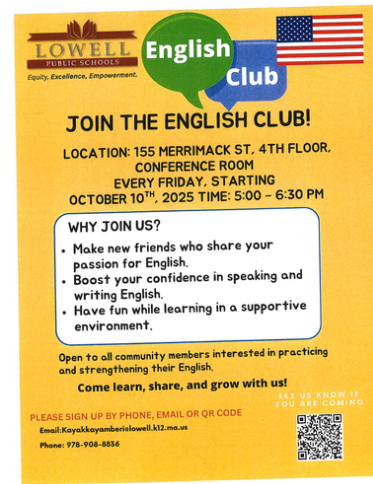
