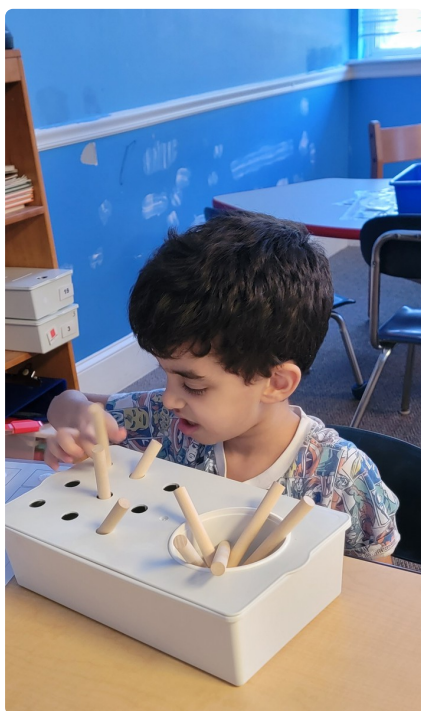

Around the school...

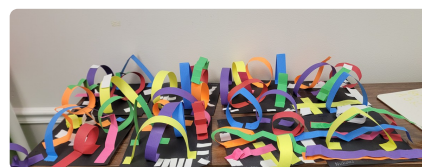

Remind App

What is Remind app for?

"Remind" is a communication platform that helps educators reach students and parents where they are. Fast: Messages are sent in real time to an entire class, a small group, or just a single person. You can also schedule announcements ahead of time and attach photos and other files.



There is a significant shortage of bus drivers. We have had different drivers each day and many times students are being switched to different buses on the way to/from school as a result of the driver shortage. In order for us to provide updated information to parents at dismissal time a fast and easier way for us to communicate with you would be through the "remind app". This is a free app that can be downloaded to your phone. It keeps your phone number and the number of the staff member private. It allows the teachers the ability to keep you informed as things come up without having to look up your numbers on the school data base or emergency forms. Phone numbers on the forms and district server tend to change or be incorrect. The remind app is more accurate and faster since it goes directly to your cell phone. If you have not signed up for the Remind app yet with your child's classroom teacher, please consider doing so. I expect the bus driver situation will not improve any time soon (nationwide issue not just this company or this district). I want to make sure you know what is going on with your child's transportation and which bus to expect (van, yellow bus) as things keep changing. Please reach out to your child's teacher for their Remind app information.
