Project Lifesaver

Lowell PD is piloting a program known as "Project Lifesaver". Students/children are provided a tracking device to wear on their wrists. This assists the police department in tracking your child if they go missing. The device is provided by the police department free of charge to the families that wish to participate in this program. Lowell Police Department's "Safe watch" program: I would like all families to consider registering their children for this program. It only takes a second for a child to go missing. By registering your child with the Safe Watch program the police department is able to gather pertinent and recent information on the child should they go missing. This will allow them the opportunity to be immediately prepared to begin an informed search, deploying resources constructively with the best chance of returning the individual as quickly as possible. 
Sensory Friendly – Tewksbury & Chelmsford
