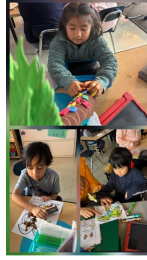
Adie School-Lowell site

Students painted pumpkins to decorate the front of our school.



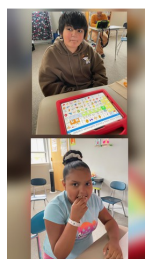
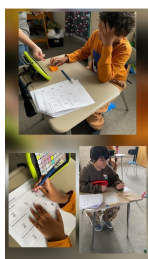
Ms. Steph's Class

- ### Halloween Safety Tips
- Plan costumes that are bright and reflective. Consider adding reflective tape or striping to costumes and trick-or-treat bags for greater visibility.
 - Make sure that shoes fit well and that costumes are short enough to prevent tripping, entanglement, or contact with flames.
 - Avoid any sharp or long words, canes, or sticks as a costume accessory. Your child can easily hit by these accessories if he or she stumbles or trips.
 - Never enter a home or car for a treat. Notify law enforcement authorities immediately about any suspicious or unlawful activity.
 - Only cross the street as a group in established crosswalks. Never cross between parked cars or out of driveways.
 - Remember the right of way. Motorists may have trouble seeing trick-or-treaters. Just because one car stops, doesn't mean others will.
 - Check candy; discard open packages, non labeled items and those with potential to choke on.
