## Back to School-week 1

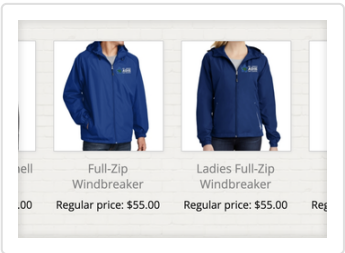
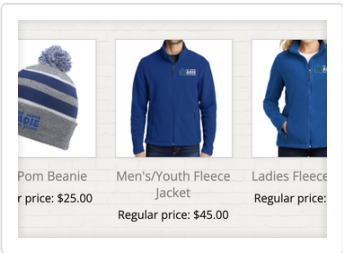
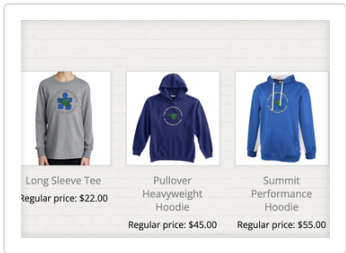
### Week 1 in the books!
