- District In Person target starts for 3%, 25% and 25% plus Target date for sub-separate populations is now February 22, 2021. Whenever staff and students return to the building, we will definitely need precautions, even after people start to be vaccinated. Vaccine is not currently approved for children. LPSD is applying to DESE to participate in in-school testing.
 - MCAS - The test is still slated to happen this year. One test session per subject (ELA, Math, and STEM for 5 and 8). Results will not impact schools' accountability level. It will be important for schools to scaffold instruction to support learners. Potential to offer academic support/programming over February and April break, as well as in the summer.
 - Fair School Funding 2021 Currently working to spend down budget for this current year. Need to plan to invest in key resources to prepare for the 2021-2022 school year. Expect to receive funding formula at the end of February so that we can plan for next year.
