Cougar Cash

Cougar Cart

Located in the school's front lobby, the Cougar Cart is where students can buy school supplies, prizes and special activities with the Cougar Cash they have earned. Cougar Cart is held on Friday afternoons.

Book Swap

Students bring an unwanted book from home to the Book Swap and leave with a new-to-them book to keep (or swap again). Grades 6 through 8 are welcome to use the Book Swap on the honor system, with teacher permission, during any free time.

Night Owl

An afternoon or evening event for students and their families which are organized and run by the PTO. Examples of a Night Owl include movie night and the Fall Festival.

Cougar Clubhouse

Students in grades kindergarten through 8 are welcome to participate in a fun activity from 1:30 to 3:30 on certain Early Release Wednesdays where the PTO provides supervision and parents/guardians provide an activity fee and transportation home on the day of the activity.

School Site Council

Meets once a month to discuss school and district-wide issues. All are welcome to attend.

RIF
