Preliminary Budget

- Fair Student Funding Workbook
- Expected 652 students started this year with 650
- With funding from outside total funding is \$6.5 mil

Last Year's Budget:

- Priorities Tier 2 & 3 interventions, UDL, PD support
- Implemented: Friday Schedule for SEL support
- Review of required minimum positions
- Fair student funding allows us to allocate our budgeted money to exactly where our needs are.
- Staff survey of concerns from last spring was 80% split between improving instruction for learning loss and SEL support for students.

Question: Do we use funds to keep at this level of funding or increase levels in some areas?

- A little of both. We can see district-wide that grade 5 has a lot of struggle. Grade 9 gets extra supports and we are looking to try to get grade 5 to have the same consideration.
- Good news: Best staffing ratio we have ever had.
 - Social Supports in place

- Pat/Tara helping put PBIS supports in place
 - Use of student history of referrals combined with new conduct referrals
 - Work with student within classroom environment as well as building therapeutic rapport outside of classroom
 - Student needs are very complex and go beyond academic needs. These connected layers help to best support them
 - Tutoring program offers extra academic support
 - April Vacation support to be offered
 - Looking at 2 layers of summer school instruction: academic and 21st Century

Question:

- Staffing to stay as we have it now?
 - Yes to staff that was hired at the beginning of year. Staff hired mid-year is still undetermined.
- Small group instruction: That is happening a lot through special education, interventionists, Els. Looking to get effective Tier 1 instruction in small groups i the classroom.
 - Challenge is finding qualified tutors/staff
- Commit by end of April to scenarios presented
- Recap ESSR
 - Parent liaison start of year
 - AP start of year
 - Tutor start of year
 - Reading specialist start of year
 - Additional para start of year
