- McAvinnue at 312 students in-person
- May 3rd, more students may return
- masks, social distancing in place, some gentle reminders provided
- Lunchtime considerations/engagement details in place

- dismissal time
 - traffic control requested for Mammoth Rd.
 - 4th Ave congested, buses unable to leave
- Vaccination Status Update
 - 65% of staff have received 2nd dose
 - some staff will receive 2nd dose soon
 - \circ some staff choosing not to receive vaccination
- Active Pool Testing
 - 78 active participants
 - Only 1 positive pool, with 1 faculty member testing positive
