Spanish: 1 responses


Portuguese: 4 responses


Only one parent responded all “Strongly Disagree.” Any other Disagree or Strongly Disagree were from varied responses on various surveys.


The school's goal is to improve student learning.



Schoolwork is meaningful and made relevant.




The school does their best to help my child learn.



So many needs in the class that my daughter ends up working independently a lot. If the teacher feels she didn't perform as she normally does then she checks in on her.


The school helps to teach the students well.

My son is afraid of school since on a few days a child hit him several times.




Students respect those who are different from them.

School leaders act fairly and with integrity.





Very good, thank you!








The school building is clean and physically safe.



Please help clear the snow on the sidewalks.



On the side where kindergarten and first grade leave, there is garbage and tall weeds.




