 - 30% higher than 500
- Stoklosa is leading Middle Schools and at or above state averages.

- Proud of achievement School of Recognition
- Recognized at School Committee Meeting.
- Looking to build upon success using data moving forward.
- Reviewed benchmarks on subgroups.
 - If there is a glaring need, the Principal will draft a proposal for SSC.
 - Provided an example with 6th grade math need and restructuring of staffing.
 - There will be times when we have to review the budget, triangulate the data and develop a solution to problem.

- During SSC, Principal will address positive things and concerns that will need to be addressed.
- SSC will then vote.

Goals for this year:

- Science instruction is lagging behind Math and ELA progress
 - Stoklosa Science leads the district
 - Progress monitoring is occurring
- ELA- new curriculum.
 - Multi-year lift to get teachers acclimated to the curriculum.
 - Lots of materials and resources.
 - We need to ensure that we are delivering curriculum properly
- Math instruction:
 - Year 4 of Illustrative Math
 - Core and Intervention math blocks successful
 - High students have not made as much progress as others.
 - This is a good problem to have.
