-Still have access to student activity account (\$11,600) and NE Biolabs grant (\$1000) to be spent by June 30th. We still need to get some type of rug protectant to go under the tables. We also need 2 additional tables which would be taken out of next years budget

- Staffing - Health teacher? Liam Skinner wants every middle school to have a health teacher. We have wellness in PE, SEL program to buy to support SEL needs,
