3. Professional Development/School Funds:

Notes:

- Library will be kid-furniture.
 - School funds from grant.
 - Opportunity to staff for Leadership opportunities/teams
 - West Ed: working with coaches on how to support teachers, will be working on backward lesson design and standards-based teaching, also on data analysis.
 - CCE will not be coming back (savings of \$30,000). West Ed will cover this
 - NOVAK is now MTSS Academy
- a. Grant funded programs will be Student council, NJHS, Community Service Team.
 - b. School PD funds RECA, West Ed (data analysis, backward lesson design, Coaching), IXL, MTSS Academy (UDL, co-teaching)
 - c. Grant/district funded programs: Money reserved for Hallmark experiences.
 - d. Grant awarded for DESE extended day /summer program grant \$60,000

 - e. Election Day- West Ed and Anti-Racism Training
 - Independent Study Block for students so teachers are able to have PLC.
 - This week and next week's PLCs will involve DESSA training and 504 training
 - Nov. 19th Parent Conferences: from Nov. 5th-19th teachers will be using PLC time for conferencing with parents.

3. Progress Monitoring:

- a. ST Math Training- during first 11 days
- b. iReady administered in ELA and math to all students in grades in 5-8 in October.
- c. Dessa Assessment being implemented
 - This is a screener for students SEL levels (Social Emotional Learning)
 - Each student will have a survey filled out by teachers; teachers will monitor SEL levels

Parent Question: What is that information going to lead to? What is the data going to show? Are there plans in place to support students in distress?

Answer: Will lead to more support for kids from the district.

4. Facilities/Safety

The custodians are doing a great job. Everyone feels very safe. Fogging is happening twice a day, doorknobs cleaned 3 times a day and that doesn't even count the night crew and the work they are doing.

Parent Question: Do the teachers have to use it?

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Answer: The feedback from teachers is that there are some racial components that are questionable. That is going to be brought to admin downtown. Robin Desmond has worked really hard to vet things for kids, so we have to make admin aware of the content. Lack of EL content. This will stay on agenda to monitor what happens.
