Scholarship Applications That Require Additional Documentation

- Additional Essay: describe how credit unions positively impact your community (200 words or less)

John J. Beaulieu Prize for Poetry

- Upload a work of poetry - please see specific requirements online or listed in bulletin

Cameroonians of Lowell (CAMOLA) Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: describe your thoughts on financial need, educational & career goals, & why receiving this scholarship is important, in addition to, describing your parents' heritage (500 words max)
- 1 Letter of Recommendation: teacher, community service supervisor or employer (REQUEST IN ADVANCE)

Cobblestones/Plath Family Culinary Arts Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: describe your culinary or hospitality work/internship experience

Don Costa Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: if you have a relationship to a former Colonial Gas employee, please explain; if none, please state, "I do not have a relationship to Colonial Gas"

Colleen Creegan Media Studio Scholarship

- Upload a 2-minute media piece or related classroom assignment describing your work in the LHS Media Studio

Michael J. Donoghue Memorial Scholarship

- Additional Essay: "We the committee, challenge the applicant to make us laugh." (200-word max)

Michael Dubois Memorial Scholarship

- Additional Essay: Discuss an accomplishment, event or realization that sparked a period of personal growth & a new understanding of yourself. We want to be pulled into your story; whether it makes us laugh or cry. Give us a sense of who you are. (500-word max).

Martin "Mickey" Finn Scholarship

- Additional Essay: discuss how you benefited from playing recreational baseball

Felicia May Johnston LHS Architecture Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: discuss the importance of female architects in the United States (500 words required)

Adam Michael Keenan Memorial Athletic Scholarship

- Additional Essay: describe the sport you are passionate about and why, and how you have overcome setbacks during your athletic career.

Jack Kerouac Prize for Literature

- Upload a work of fiction- please see specific requirements listed online or in bulletin.

Jack Kerouac Scholarship Fund

- Upload a work of prose, poetry, literary criticism, or journalism.

LHS Alumni Chorus Scholarship

- Additional Essay: "why I have chosen music as an academic career" (250 words max)

LHS Visual Arts Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: "how will a college education help me to achieve my goal to become an artist, designer or art educator"
- Upload electronic portfolio.

Rita Sharcoff Mizner Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: describe your interest in pursuing the field of public education.

Amsi Morales Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: "tell us one thing you hope to do/accomplish during your college years" (500-word max)
- 1 Letter of Recommendation: teacher, community service supervisor, or employer (REQUEST IN ADVANCE)

Supt. Henry J. and Theresa R. Mroz Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: describe how you have displayed exemplary behavior exercising the golden rule ("Do unto others as you would have others do unto you") in the context of an important personal experience.

Frederick T. Murphy Jr. Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: address the following topic, "the highest reward for man's toil is not what he gets from it, but what he becomes by it" (250-word max)

People's Club of Lowell Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: "how has living in Lowell broadened your formal education and influenced what you intend to do in the future" (750-word max)

Plomaritis Family Foundation Seven Tenets Scholarship Award

- Additional Essay: encompassing your volunteer experience, how will you portray the "SEVEN TENETS" moving forward: DEVELOPMENT, DIRECTION, DISCIPLINE, RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, LEADERSHIP, & SPORTSMANSHIP
- New this year- Letters of Recommendation are NOT REQUIRED

Portuguese-American Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: address the following topic, "William Madison Wood" (550-1100 words)

Katina Pappas Tsongas Memorial Scholarship Fund

- Additional Essay: demonstrate your awareness of women's issues (500 words)

Paul Tsongas/University of Massachusetts Lowell Scholarship

- Additional Essay: discuss your service to the school and/or community and the effect that this service has had on your life (550-word max)
- 3 Letters of Recommendation: 1 letter must be from a community service supervisor (REQUEST IN ADVANCE)
- Community Service Documentation: signed by a supervisor that verifies the dates, hours and services provided.

Important Notes:

Students must meet the eligibility criteria to submit an Honors Night Scholarship application for any listed scholarship. All documents must be completed 100% to successfully submit your application; if you don't wish to apply, please click on Abandon Request.
