2. Budget & HR:

3. School Improvement Planning, PD, & Enrichment

- ILT Writing goals for next year. Turn Around plan will end next year, but the Quality Improvement Plan continues. There are 4 components to the plan, and we are maintaining many of the same goals and continuing to build on the work that has been done over the past several years. This includes:
 - PLC Meetings
 - ILT Team
 - Instructional Goals will maintain writing and reading focus, and will add a focus on analysis and inquiry. This will include higher order thinking and expressing academic thinking,
 - UDL: UDL looking at different access point for students in intervention that will help to build reasoning skills
 - Teacher Assistance Team - Any students who are failing 1 or more classes will be referred immediately to the TAT
 - Daily Intervention Classes
 - Looking at school suspension numbers

4. Progress Monitoring:

1. Iready results- Bridget Dowling shared the Iready scores in both math and reading in order to highlight the growth that has occurred over the past several months. There was a question from a member or the site council member in terms of obtaining a copy of Iready scores for individual students.
