

Something's Not Quite Right

One cool activity that aids younger students with observation skills is called Something's Not Quite Right. Before the day starts, create chaos in a common room by purposely misplacing a few items. This could mean that one of the vases in the living room is out of place, a chair or fixture is missing out the kitchen, a small item is missing from any other common area in the house. Give students an observation sheet, place them into groups, and have them explore the room looking for abnormalities. Once they've had enough time to observe the room, discuss their findings in a whole group setting.
