Content Literacy :

Hey Kindergarten! This week we are going to learn about money and the different coins. I am even going to give you directions to try a coin rubbing!! It's like magic! I want you to watch this read aloud "The Coin Counting Book."

After watching, try this, try a fun coin rubbing activity. Use your favorite colored crayons and create some coin rubbings. Try a penny, nickel, dime and quarter.

Compare the sizes.

What do you notice that is the same/different with each coin? Are the edges of each coin the same?

Directions: To make a rubbing of a coin, have students place the coin under a piece of white paper. Thinner paper like computer paper works best. Use a crayon and gently rub the colored tip over the coin until the coin design appears.
