McAvinnue's Budget Workbook

- 2020-2021: \$5,006,913
- 2021-2022: \$5,373,041
- Per teacher increase of \$4000 from previous year
- Start with the replication of the 2020-2021 school year budget items for the 2021-2022 school year
- Tutors for Intervention support- 5 tutor positions created
- Title I tutors, Title III tutors : 3-4
- Parent liaison stipends- 4 areas to concentrate on
- Increase in SEL needs: bring in a half time social worker: .5 position, 15 hrs per week, \$57,000
- Instructional Supplies: \$96,000
- Presented and defended April 1st at 2pm: Central Office Administration
